4. A Picture of Salvation. 1 Peter 3:20-21

- God waited patiently for the disobedient in the days of Noah to come to Him and He is still waiting now for people to come to Him through _____.
- What were the people doing in the days of Noah?
 - They were eating and drinking, marrying, and being given in marriage
 - Genesis 6:11-12 says the earth (people) were corrupt in God's sight, the earth was filled with violence,
 - Genesis 4:4 says people were wicked, and that all they thought about was how to do evil.
 - Noah the "Preacher of Righteousness" (2 Peter 2:3) warning his friends, neighbors...everyone, what Holy God was about to do. No. One. Listened.
 - Their sin, and refusal to change their heart caused them to be killed in the flood. – it was their own choice. They had heard the gospel, and knew the consequence. Just like you do.
 - The 8 that listened family were saved from the storm/rain, the others perished.
